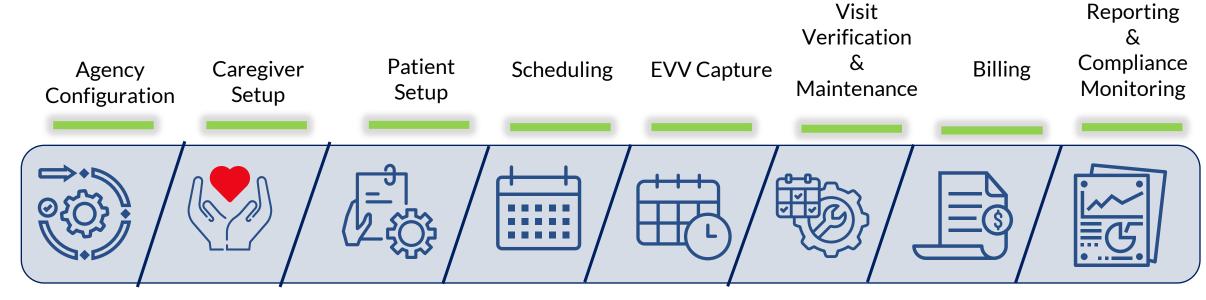

Correcting claims



Denied Claims

If your claim is denied by the MCO after being invoiced in HHAeXchange:

- Review visit start and end times to ensure accuracy.
- Verify the **service code** matches the authorization.
- Confirm the caregiver is correctly assigned to the visit.
- Review diagnosis code under the authorization.
- Update and resubmit once corrections are made.

Tip: Most denials are caused by visit data issues, so check these areas first before reaching out for support.



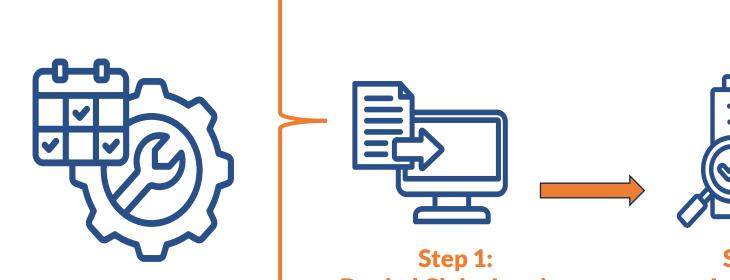

Step 2: **Denied Claim Invoice Invoicing**

-Review and correct visit data

-Generate an invoice

Step 3: Resubmission

-Resubmit claims directly through HHAeXchange



Denied Claim invoice





Steps: Billing > Invoice search

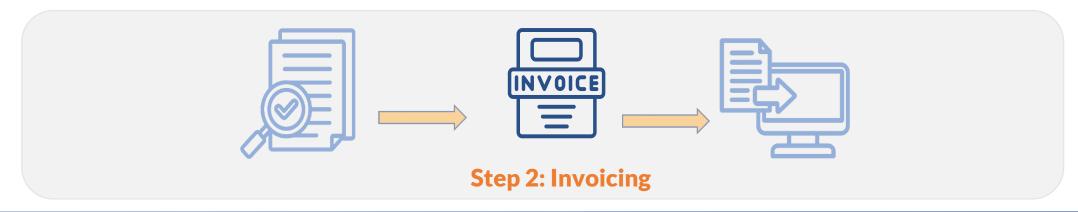
Purpose: Review and correct the data.

- Review Visits ensure caregiver times are accurate
- Verify Service code ensure the visit is using the correct service code.
- Remove visits from invoice



Invoicing





Steps: Billing > New Invoice (Internal)

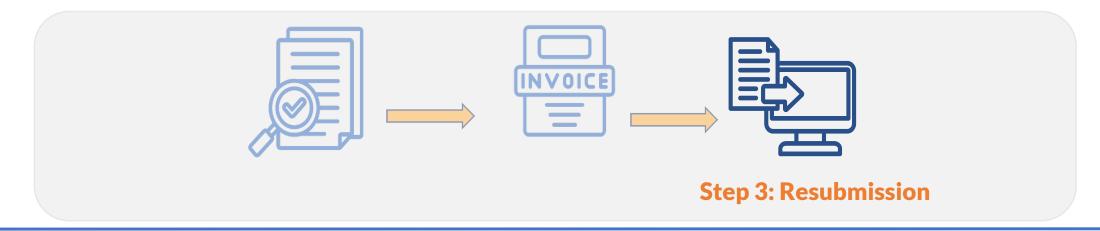
Purpose: Generate invoices based on billable visits.

- •Create Invoice: Select the appropriate time period and services to create an invoice
- •Verify Invoice Details: Review the invoice for accuracy, including service codes, and amounts



Resubmission





Steps: Billing Claims with MCO

Purpose: Resubmit claims through HHAeXchange.

- After visits have been corrected and invoiced, claims should be resubmitted directly to HHAeXchange.
- The MCO will verify claims based on invoiced claims in HHAeXchange.



Correcting Invoices





Scenario: The biller has received a denied claim based on a mismatched invoice in HHAeXchange. The biller will need to remove the visit to correct it and rebill.

Steps:

- Navigate to **Billing > Invoice search > Batch search**
- Click Search.
- Select **Invoice batch** and look for the invoice.
- Find the visit and go to the **Delete** icon.



- 5. Select the **Delete visit.**
- Select Reason for Deletion and select Delete.







Scenario: The biller has received a denied claim based on a mismatched invoice in HHAeXchange. Now that the visit has been removed from the invoice. The biller will go and correct the visit.

Steps:

- 1. Navigate to **Patient > Patient search**
- 2. Click **Search**.
- 3. Select Patient
- 4. Find and select the visit that needs to be corrected.
- 5. If applicable, update the **Caregiver**, **Confirmed times**, **Diagnosis Code**, and or **Service code**.
- 6. Save the visit.

Invoicing





Scenario: The biller has corrected the visits and now is ready to reinvoice them.

Steps:

- 1. Navigate to **Billing > New Invoice Internal**
- 2. Add the Date range, offices, and optionally any other filters.
- 3. Click Search.
- 4. Review billable visits, also make sure that the visit has an amount.
- 5. Select the billable visits to add to the invoice or add all to batch.
- 6. Click Select Generate Invoice to complete the batch.

Billing Review & Electronic Billing





Steps: Billing > Billing Review



Any visits in Billing Review CANNOT be electronically submitted until issues are corrected

Most Common Billing Review Problems:

 Pending Billing of Additional Shifts on Same Day – Only one visit has been invoiced on a day with multiple visits

Electronic Billing



Generate E-Billing Batch

Scenario: The biller has re-invoiced the visit and is now ready to generate e-billing batch for resubmission.

Steps:

- 1. Navigate to Billing > Electronic Billing > E-Submission Batches
- 2. Select "Add Original Claims"
- 3. Select MCO and Add Claims option.
- 4. Add applicable filters and click **Search**.
- 5. Select Visits to resubmit and click Add.
- 6. Select edit option to update submission type (Adjustment and add TRN Number)
- 7. Select "Save Batch and Send" option.





Reports





Scenario:

Barbara has been performing services for a week, and I want to check on her EVV progress. To do so, I am going to use the EVV Compliance by Caregiver (New) Report.

Steps:

- 1. Navigate to Reports > EVV Compliance reports > EVV compliance by caregiver.
- 2. Select date range, office, and caregiver names.
- 3. Select View Report.
- 4. Review EVV exceptions and EVV Compliance percentage columns.
- 5. Click **Export** and choose preferred Format.

- 3. Optionally add the batch number or just select **Generate Report**.
- 4. Select the format and it will be generated.

- Invoices can be reviewed in Invoice search.
- Visits that need to be corrected should be removed from the invoice first.
- Once the visit has been corrected, it can be invoiced again.
- Visit report can be used to review visits.
- Billing reports can be used to review billed invoices.
- For Alt-EVV/EDI Providers, Registration does not equal integration. You must register to have a portal, but you also need to submit an EDI ticket through HHAeXchange Support to officially start the setup & integration process.
- Ensure you check with Humana Healthy Horizons of Virginia or the HHAeXchange State Info Hub for the most recent updates to the service codes in scope for billing

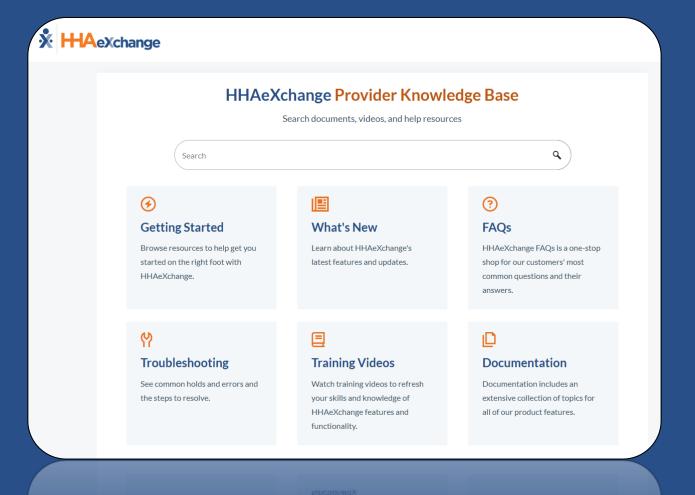

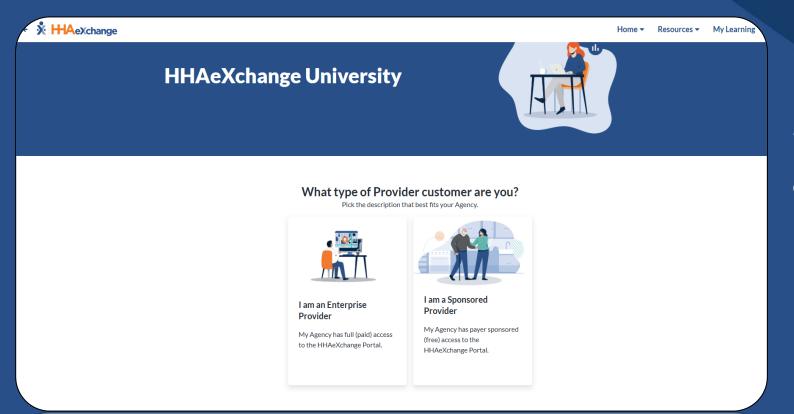

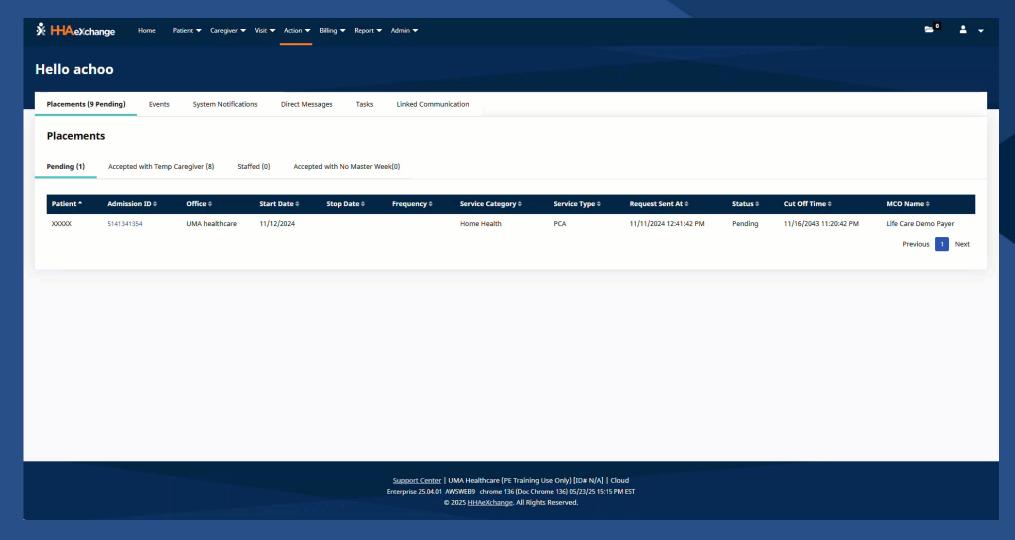
